# L. a. ENEMY DEFENSE:

- (1) Target is BOLOGNA MAIN M/Y. Secondary target is any active M/Y in the PO VALLEY. There are thirty-three heavy A/A guns in the target area.
- (2) There are ninety enemy fighters in the target area but little opposition is expected.

- RESULTS: Good concentration on east end of Marshelling Yards. One vew large explosion observed. A few bombs carried over into city.
